Emergency Housing Assistance Program (EHA)

Assisting Households who have been impacted by the COVID-19 Pandemic

Program information.

About the Program

Nome Eskimo Community Housing Program was allocated Indian Housing Block Grant (IHBG) American Rescue Plan (ARP) implementation of the Emergency Housing Assistance Program (EHA).

The EHA Program provides temporary emergency housing assistance to avoid displacement due to ongoing unemployment, reduction in income, significant increased costs, or other financial hardship due directly or indirectly to the COVID-19 pandemic.

EHA Households may be eligible to receive up to three (3) months of the following services to eligible applicants:

- Emergency Rental Assistance
- Emergency Utility Assistance
 - Electric/water & sewer services
 - Heating Fuel and Propane

How do I get a copy of the NEC EHA application?

If you have internet access, you can go to our website at www.necalaska.org and fill out our application.

You can request a copy of the application by sending an email to erap@necalaska.org. You can pick up an application in person at NEC offices located at 200 West 5th Ave. Nome, AK

You can request a copy of the application to be mailed or faxed by calling our offices at 907-443-2246

All applications must be completed in accordance with the instructions in the program's application and will be accepted until the deadline October 14, 2022.

How do I submit my application?

Applicants are encouraged to confirm with staff if their application has been received and are completed for review. Completed applications can be submitted:

How do I know if I am eligible?

The main applicant must be a Nome Eskimo Tribal member and at least 18 years old or older.

You or a member of your household meets the following criteria:

- Qualifies for or is currently unemployment benefits.
- Has been or is currently unemployed.
- Has incurred significant increased costs due to the COVID-19 pandemic.
- Has lost income due directly or indirectly to the COVID-19 pandemic.
- Your household's income must equal to or less than 80%-100% of the area median income for which the household is located in the Nome service.
